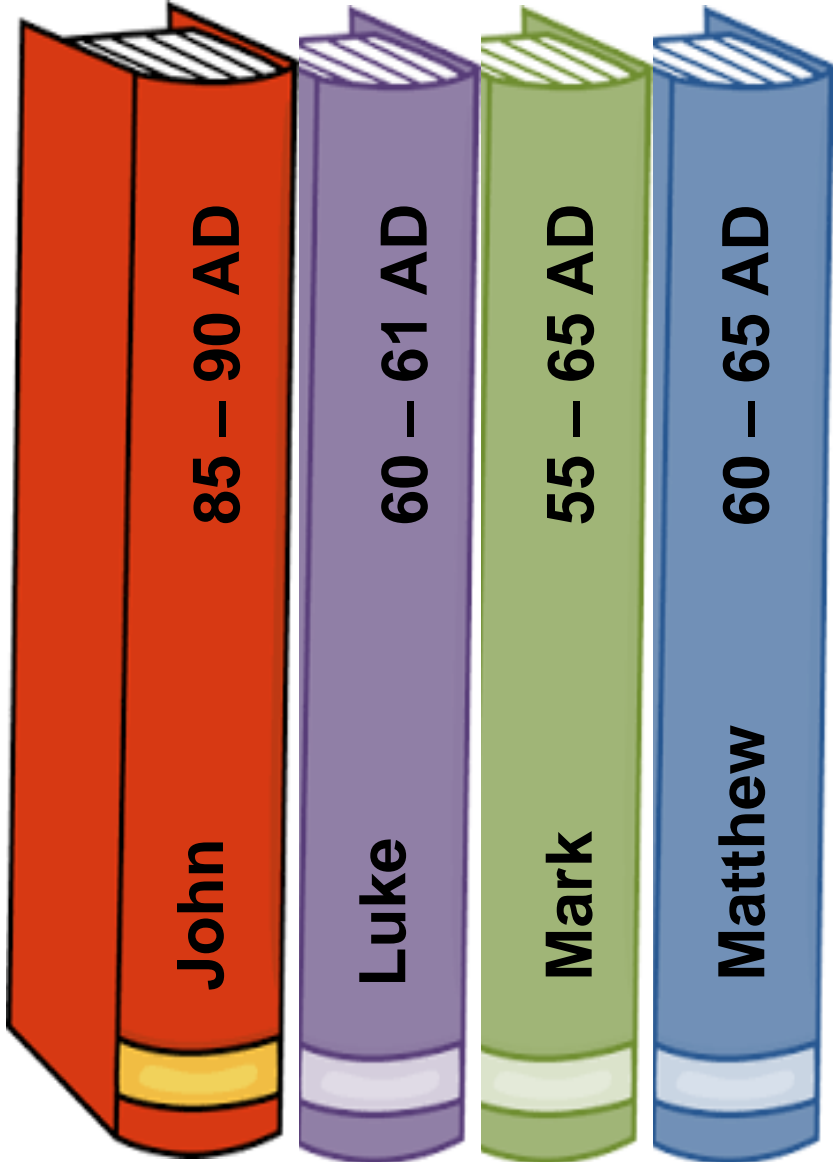
The New Testament

1. Jesus Crucified, disciples hid themselves for fear
2. Jesus rose again, appeared for 40 days, the Great commission
3. Holy Spirit promise fulfilled, power (50 days after resurrection)
4. Apostles preaching (by word): 3000 saved, miracles
5. Preaching spread (by word): Jerusalem, Judea, and Samaria
6. Saul of Tarsus conversion
7. Paul & Barnabas started mission trips
8. Preaching is done by the apostles (eye witnesses)
9. Letters started to be written
10. Gospels started to be written (testimony of eye witnesses)

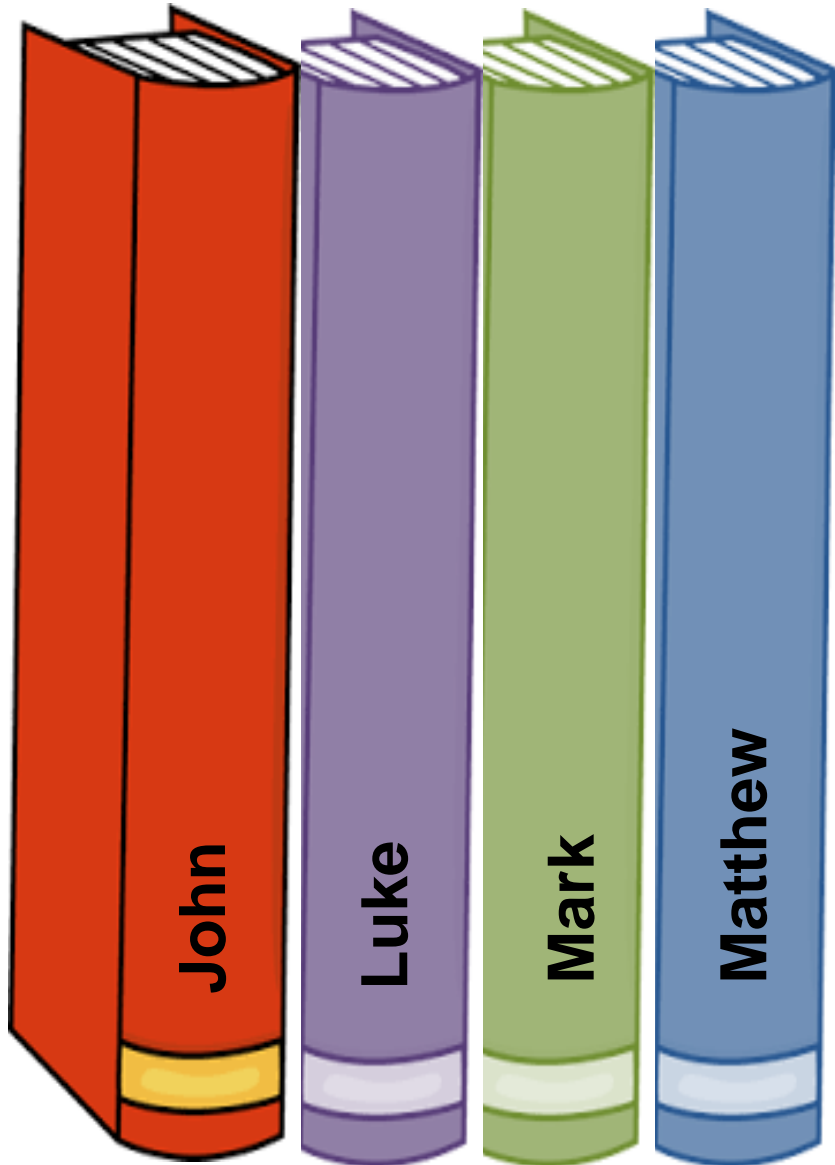

(Deuteronomy 19: 15) A single witness shall not rise up against a man on account of any iniquity or any sin which he has committed; on the evidence of two or three witnesses a matter shall be confirmed.

وَإِنْ لَمْ يَسْمَعْ، فَخُذْ مَعَكَ أَيْضًا وَاحِدًا أَوْ اثْنَيْنِ، لِكَيْ تَقُومَ كُلُّ
كَلِمَةٍ عَلَى فَمِ شَاهِدَيْنِ أَوْ ثَلَاثَةٍ.

(Matthew 18: 16) But if he does not listen to you, take one or two more with you, so that by the mouth of two or three witnesses every fact may be confirmed.

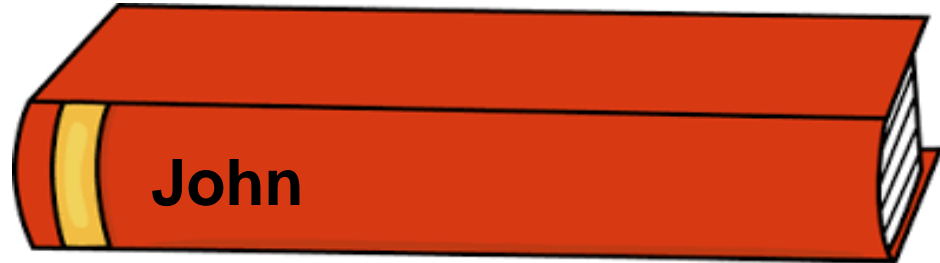
The Testimony of Two Disciples

- Eye Witnesses, Life, Miracles, Teaching, Glory, Death, Resurrection

The Testimony of Two Non-Disciples

- Mark (Disciple of Peter, accompanied Paul, nephew of Barnabas)
- Luke (Gentile, Physician, accompanied Paul)

Everyone: Jesus is the Son of God



Greeks: Jesus the Perfect Man



Romans: Jesus the Perfect Servant



Jews: Jesus the promised Messiah, King

Matthew (28 Chapters)

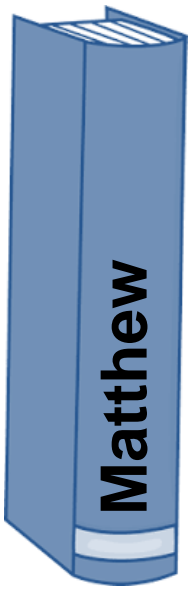
Matthew

1. Sermon on the Mount (5-7)
2. Calling & Sending the 12 disciples (10)
3. Parables of the Kingdom (13)
4. Believers like Children in the Kingdom (18)
5. Olivet discourse (23-25)

- Full of Messianic Language (“Son of David”)
- 123 Quotations and References to O.T
- Not a Chronological account
- Purpose to Present proof that Jesus is the Messiah, the Savior, The King



Matthew (28 Chapters)



- **Chapters 1 – 4** **Birth & Preparation of Jesus, the King**
Jesus from the Royal Line, birth of the King
His Kingdom an Everlasting Kingdom, no end (Herod & Satan afraid of Him)
- **Chapters 4 – 25** **Message & Ministry of Jesus, the King**
Jesus begins His ministry, sermon on the mount
Jesus performs many miracles, Jesus teaches about the Kingdom
Jesus confronts religious leaders
Jesus teaches on the Mount of Olives
- **Chapters 26 – 28** **Death & Resurrection of Jesus, The King**
Jesus formally presented to the nation of Israel and rejected
The King betrayed, falsely accused, tried, crucified
Jesus proves He is the King, power over death, rises again from death
Jesus commission to his disciples

Mark (16 Chapters)

- Chp. 1 Birth & Preparation of Jesus, the Servant
- Chp. 2–13 Message & Ministry of Jesus, the Servant
- Chp. 14–16 Death & Resurrection of Jesus, the Servant

No Lineage?

About 40 times (Immediately, Straight away)

The one who came to serve is the Son of God

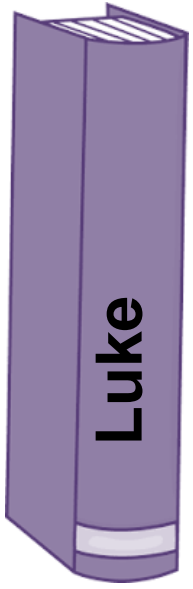
Who is this?

Jesus had all the power of almighty God – raised the dead, gave sight to the blind, quieted the storm and the sea, YET...

He came as a servant? Why?

لَأَنَّ ابْنَ الْإِنْسَانِ أَيْضًا لَمْ يَأْتِ لِيُخْدَمَ بَلْ لِيُخْدِمَ وَلِيَبْدِلَ نَفْسَهُ فِدْيَةً عَنْ كَثِيرِينَ.

(Mark 10: 45) For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.”



Luke (24 Chapters)

- Chapters 1 – 4 Birth & Preparation of Jesus, the Savior
- Chapters 5 – 21 Message & Ministry of Jesus, the Savior
- Chapters 22 – 24 Death & Resurrection of Jesus, The Savior

Jesus (God's Son), entered human history

- Lived as the perfect man
- Performed perfect ministry
- Provided perfect sacrifice

Jesus's compassion on Gentiles, Samaritans, Women, Children, Tax collectors and sinners (Great Doctor: Luke 5: 31-32, 15: 7)

فَقَالَ لَهُ يَسُوعُ: «الْيَوْمَ حَصَلَ خَلاصٌ لِهَذَا الْبَيْتِ، إِذْ هُوَ أَيْضًا ابْنُ إِبْرَاهِيمَ،
10 لِأَنَّ ابْنَ الْإِنْسَانِ قَدْ جَاءَ لِكَيْ يَطْلُبَ وَيُخَلِّصَ مَا قَدْ هَلَكَ.»

(Luke 19: 9-10) And Jesus said to him, “Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham. ¹⁰ For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.”
