1. The miracles of Jesus, his words, and declarations about himself caused a division among the Jews (John 7: 43, 9: 16). What caused their division this time (John 10: 19)?
2. How do you respond to those who read the Bible, listen to evidences, but continue to express their doubts and questioning?
3. What is the relationship between the Old Testament prophecies (Isaiah 53: 2-3, Psalm 118: 22-23, Matthew 21: 42) and the position of the Jews towards the Messiah?
4. How do you respond to attacks on the Deity of Christ (John 10: 20)? Give three references that you may use from the Bible.
5. The Feast of Dedication (Hanukah = dedication), commemorates the cleansing and re-dedication of the Temple in 164 BC, after it was defiled by Antiochus IV when he sacrificed a pig. What did the Jews meant by their question: "If you are the Messiah, tell us plainly?" They desired to believe or was it a trap to accuse him? Defend!
6. Jesus referenced Psalm 82: 2-6, where God called the judges of Israel gods. What was meant? And were they good judges or evil ones?
7. What assures you that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God; God Eternal, equal with God (John 10: 30)?
8. A sheep is afraid of getting lost, or becoming a prey. What does Christ provide to the sheep that believe on him (John 10: 27-28)?
