

1. What was Jesus referring to when he said to Peter “do you love me more than these” (there can be more than one answer to this question)

2. Many times we want to have a genuine love for the Lord but sometimes things come between us and our love for the Lord. Discuss how our love for Jesus competes with the love of other things.

3. In everything that Jesus said and did he always made sure his actions were full of Grace. Discuss how the questions of Jesus to Peter demonstrate this.

4. How did you experience this grace in your life?

5. After denying the Lord 3 times, Peter felt very bad and guilty yet later on, Peter became one of the founders of the early church. How was the Lord able to restore Peter and transform him into the Peter we know. (one chapter in our life may mark us but will not define our life)

6. What were some of the reasons that led to Peter’s denying that he knew the Lord. Read Mat 26:31 to 35

7. What can we do to protect ourselves from falling in sin or from doing the wrong thing (read James 1:13-14, 1 Peter 5:8-9, 1 Corinthians 10:12, 1 John 2:1-2)
