1. Read John 7:1

Was Jesus afraid of the Jews? Justify your answer.

- 2. Read vers. 2 to 9, Why were the brothers of Jesus pressing on him to go with them to the festival knowing full well that his life might be in danger there?
- 3. Read vers 6 & 7,

What can we conclude from Jesus saying "my time is not yet here" in these 2 verses?

- 4. After a few verses Jesus eventually goes up to the festival, so why is it then that he did not want to go with his brothers?
- 5. What do you do when your friends or co-workers (for those who have jobs) pressure you to do things you know you do not want to do, but you do not want to let them down yet you want to please the Lord?
- 6. Read verses 14 to 31. Jesus' questions and answers to the Jews were a bit unclear and confusing.
 - How did the jews react to his questions and answers?
 - Do you feel sometimes that the Lord is unclear to you, and how do you react to that?
 - Why are the Lord's dealing with us sometimes unclear and confusing?
- 7. Read vers 37 to 44, some of the people had the wrong assumptions about Jesus origin, and this assumption lead them to draw the wrong conclusion about who he really is. How do you deal with your own assumptions to discover if they are true or false?
