**Turning water into wine:**

- 1) What do you learn about Jesus from this miracle?
  
- 2) (John 2: 11) says: "This was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him". What made you believe in Jesus? What did Jesus do personally in your life so that you believe in him?
  
- 3) What did the servants do that showed their faith in Jesus? What is the lesson for us?
  
- 4) A man invites Jesus to his wedding. How did Jesus' presence affect the wedding? How does Jesus' presence affect your life or is he a burden?
  
- 5) How do you describe water (characteristics: example no color...) what does it mean that Jesus can turn water into wine?

**Jesus Cleanses the Temple:**

- 6) What do we learn about anger in this event? Is it OK?
  
- 7) Gradually, people started selling things in the temple. Eventually it became a market instead of a house for prayers. What things enter our lives gradually then they become major?
  
- 8) (1 Corinthians 3: 16, 6: 19) Our bodies are temples for the Holy Spirit that lives in us. The Lord revealed his authority by cleansing the temple. List the things that the Lord needs to cleanse from my own life? So he can live in me, and I become a true temple.
  
- 9) (John 2: 23-25) Many believed in his name. Jesus did not entrust himself to them. Can someone believe in Jesus but Jesus would not trust. What does it mean?
