5. What quality and attribute strikes you the most in Jesus during his trial? How can you learn from him? Obedience, Submission, Love, humility, meekness, forgiveness.

6. From the Bible, who were the people that testified "they found no fault in Jesus, innocent, righteous"? Why was he crucified?
