

1. Why did Mary Magdalene go so early to the tomb while it was still dark? (Mark 16: 1-3).

Mary Magdalene arrived ahead, what was her big surprise?

Why did she leave quickly, and where did she go (John 20: 2)?

2. John 20: 5-7 says "The strips of linen were not unwrapped but still lying in its place, while the cloth that was wrapped around Jesus' head was folded in a place by itself". What does that mean to you?
3. Why did the angel say to the women "come and see the place where he was lying", then he charged them "to go and tell" (Matthew 28: 6-7); similarly Jesus told Mary Magdalene "to go and tell" (John 20: 17).
4. Peter and John ran to the tomb, eventually both went inside and saw the evidence, but it says that \_\_\_\_\_ believed.
5. Put the following sentences in order (consult Matthew 28, Mark 16, Luke 24 & John 20)
  - \_\_\_: Mary Magdalene arrived to the tomb, found the stone rolled away from the tomb
  - \_\_\_: The other women with spice arrived to the tomb early in the morning
  - \_\_\_: Mary Magdalene went alone to tell Peter and John
  - \_\_\_: The other women enter the tomb, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus
  - \_\_\_: Two men suddenly stood beside them with shining garments
  - \_\_\_: Why do you seek the living among the dead?
  - \_\_\_: The other women went to tell the disciples
  - \_\_\_: Peter and John muster some courage and run to the tomb
  - \_\_\_: Mary Magdalene outside the tomb crying, then bends over to look into the tomb
  - \_\_\_: Mary Magdalene sees two angels in white, seated one at the head and the other at the foot
  - \_\_\_: The angels ask Mary Magdalene "Woman, why are you crying?"
  - \_\_\_: Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene, and calls her by her name
  - \_\_\_: Jesus charges Mary Magdalene to go and tell the disciples
  - \_\_\_: Mary Magdalene tells the disciples: Jesus is alive and I saw him, they did not believe her
  - \_\_\_: Jesus meets Mary the mother of James and another women near the tomb, they worshiped him
  - \_\_\_: Jesus appears to two men on the road to Emmaus
  - \_\_\_: Jesus appeared to the disciples (but Thomas was not)
  - \_\_\_: Jesus showed them his hands and his feet
