

1. In light of Jesus' knowledge (verse 3) that "the father had put all things under his power", what surprises you about Jesus as he washed the disciples feet?
2. What would trouble you more, washing someone's feet or letting them wash your feet?

Why?

3. Jesus spent more than three years teaching his disciples with his words, why did he choose this time the lesson to be in action (Luke 9: 46, 22: 24)?
4. Washing the feet of his disciples was a voluntary act with total humility. On the other hand each disciple accepted it. What is the spiritual and deeper meaning (Read verse 8 carefully)?
5. What is the attitude that Jesus expects his followers to have (verse 14, 17; Philippians 2: 1-10)?

Give practical examples.

6. What would have been your reaction if you were at the table that night, and Jesus came to wash your feet? What if he asked you to wash the feet of the others, would you?
7. Explain verse 8 "Unless I wash you, you have no part with me"
