- 1) Why did Pilot order Jesus to be flogged? (John 19:1-3)
- 2) Pilot and Herod kept asking Jesus questions, but Jesus answered only few of their questions (read Mat 27:11-14 and John 19:7-9) why did he not answer all of their questions?
- 3) From the Bible text in John 19:7, 8, 12-16 and also john 18:38 we notice that Pilot changed his mind about what to do with Jesus many times, why was that?
- 4) The Bible says that neither Pilot not Herod found any fault in Jesus (Luke 23:14-16 and 22). Do you think that Pilot really believed that Jesus was innocent and did not deserve to die?
- 5) Based on your answer above, why then did Pilot order him to be crucified?

6) In our daily life, do our actions always show harmony with our faith? Is our faith sometimes out of convenience?
